


Electric Power Dolly Instruction Manual


Failure to observe these instructions couldlead to serious injury or death.

- 1. Always Know Your Dolly Take time to fully read the Installation and Operator's Guide, in order to understand your dolly and its operations.
- 2. Never store battery pack in a tool box or pocket with nails, screws, keys, etc. Shorting of battery terminal may cause fire.
- 3. Always avoid contact with battery leakage, which may occur under extreme usage or temperature conditions.
- 4. Always dispose or recycle battery according to local ordinances I regulations.
- 5. Always protect terminals with insulating tape, prior to disposal, to prevent shorting.
- 6. Never attempt to disassemble the battery. No use rserviceable parts are inside.
- 7. Never charge damaged battery packs, replace damaged pack immediately. Battery short or fire may result.
- 8. Never incinerate the battery pack even If it is severely damaged or is completely worn out.
- 9. Never operate pulling tool in an environment containing explosive or combustible material.
- 10. Always remove the battery when the unit is not in use.
- 12. Never charge damaged battery packs, replace damaged battery pack immediately. Battery short or fire may result.
- 13. Always use Landworks charger to charge lead-acid battery pack, Other types of batteries may burst causing damage and injury to person.
- 14. Never operate charger with damaged cord or plug. Replace them immediately.
- 15. Never use Landworks charger to charge other batteries.
- 16. Never operate charger if it has received a sharp blow, been dropped or otherwise damaged in any way.
- 17. Never charge battery in damp or wet environment. Do not cover the charger with clothes or similar items during charging.
- 18. The use of accessories which not recommended or supplied by the charger manufacturer may present a risk of fire, electric shock or personal injury.
- 19. Always charge battery at temperatures between32°F-120°F (0°C-49°).
- 20. Always store battery at temperatures between 32°F-86°F (0°C-30°C).
- 21. Always disconnect charger when battery is fully charged.
- 22. Always charge battery every three months if not in use.
- 23. Do not exceed the maximum capacity of the towing tool: Trailer weight: 1620kgs / 3600lbs, tongue weight: 270kgs / 600lbs.
- 24. Make sure the hitch ball and the coupler are locked reliably before towing
- 25. Always use factory approved mounting hardware, components, and accessories.
- 26. Do not pull the dolly on the downhill road, always make sure that the traction road is flat, and the slope angle is less than 4 degrees when pulling on the uphill.
- 27. Do not use power dolly to move people.
- 28. Do not operate this power dolly under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- 29. Be sure to remove any elements or obstacles that may hinder the safe operation of the power dolly.
- 30. When installing, assembling, repairing or not using the power dolly, be sure to disconnect the power supply of the dolly.
- 31. Never operate or install the pulling tool without reading or understanding the operator's manual.
- 32. Never operate this dolly if you are under 16 years old.






2. Hitch ball mount assembly

Fit in the washer and nuts into adjustable ball mount, thread the hitch ball till completely fit. (See Figure 2)






3. Assemble the swivel wheel Put the swivel wheel shaft into the force frame, fixed by nut and bolt (See Figure 3)





4. Rear wheel assembly

Install the rear wheel on the axle, insert the flat key and fixed by bolts. We suggest to install the rear wheels with the inflating inlet at the outside so for easy inflating. (See Figure 4)



 Assemble the adjustable hitch ball mount: Adjust the ball mount with the required height, fix by the latch and locked with pin. (See Figure 5)




6. Connecting rod assembly Connect the battery cable from the top tube of the force frame, and put out from the round hole in the middle of the connecting rod (gentle reminding: there are 2 holes in two side of the force frame and hole bottom, which are assistant for your observation during the cable connection.) (See Figure 6)


7. Battery Assembly

Put out the battery wire from the inside hole on the battery box, screwed the battery box on the force frame by bolts. (See Figure 7)




8. Battery & Controller Assembly

Place 2*12V lead acid battery into the box. DO NOT TOUCH THE BATTERY'S POSITIVE AND NEGATIVE BY ANY METAL PARTS. Otherwise there will be fire caused and lead a danger to the user. (See Figure 8)

Electrical schematic diagram






POWER SWITCH CONNECTION



Contol Switch Controller




Motor Connection



10. After the wire connection, locked the battery box, sealed by the plug, installation finished. **(See Figure 10)**


BEFORE USE


- 1. Check the power dolly and make sure all bolts had been well screwed and the hitch ball mount can be locked.
- Check all the wheels to make sure they are keep in well working status, be sure the tire pressure are among 30±2psi(2.1±0.1kg/cm2)
- 3. Check the battery volume and make sure the switch are workable.
- 4. Start the dolly before loading onto the trailer and check the dolly can forward and reverse freely
- 5. Make sure the trailer weight no more than 1620kgs/3600Lb and tongue weight under 270kgs/600Lb
- 6. Please use this dolly on flat road only. For your safety purpose, do not use it on the slop over 4 degree. No brake installed so do not use on the minus grade.




OPERATION


- 1. Move the dolly close to the trailer weld spots, adjust the ball hitch mount in correct height. Normally leave the hitch ball 100-200mm over the weld spots, locked the hitch ball mount by latch and pin. (See Figure 11)
- 2. Hold the assembled Ball Mount underneath the hitch. With the Weld Spots in the correct position, insert the Ball into the Hitch and lock it as normal.







- 3. Switch on the power and speed controller button. Check the battery status. Switch the button into Drive or Revise, and move the dolly by the speed controller knob. The speed can be various from 0-2.5km/h. (See Figure 13)
- 4. Shut down the power after use. And park the dolly in the correct position. PLEASE RECHARGE THE BATTERY WITHN 3 MONTHS OTHERWISE THE LEAD ACID BATTERY MAY BE DESTRIED.




OVERLOAD PROTECTION

The dolly equipped with overload protection system, will shut down while over loaded. This will protect the potential risk of the machine destroy. Please do not try to start when the dolly overloaded and shut down, please re-start after the loading weight reduced within the capacity.

TROUBLE SHOOTING
